The XFL championship game features the two top teams from the north and south divisions who dominated all season.

To get to the championship game, Arlington crushed the Houston Renegades 26-11 while D.C. did the same against the Seattle Sea Dragons 37-21.

This collision in the championship game has been inevitable since early in the XFL season and promises to be one of the most exciting football games of the year.

The DC Defenders have been the class of the field in getting to this stage.

They won nine of their 10 regular-season games, including a 28-26 win over tonight's opponents.

The Arlington Renegades had just a 4-6 record in the regular-season but they came up good when it mattered in the Division Finals against their Texas rivals.

Arlington beat Houston Roughnecks 26-11 to take up their spot in tonight's Championship Game.

The XFL returned on February 18 more than two decades on from it's one and only season to much fanfare.

Celebrity owners The Rock and Dany Garcia were in attendance at Choctaw Stadium in Arlington, Texas for the inaugural game three months ago.

Eight teams played 10 regular-season games each over the weeks that followed.

We had our semifinals two weeks ago, or Division Finals, where the DC Defenders beat the Seattle Sea Dragons and the Arlington Renegades defeated the Houston Roughnecks.

And that brings us to tonight - the Championship Game at the Alamodome in San Antonio.
